

Dubois County Courthouse

1 Courthouse Square, Jasper; 812.481.7000 A Renaissance Revival-style building designed in 1910 and renovated in 1996, this prominent 4-story structure currently serves as the county's courthouse. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Jasper City Mill

160 3rd Ave., Jasper; 812.482.4924 or 812.482.5959; historicjasper.com

Jasper City Mill was recently constructed to resemble the former mill that once stood near the Patoka River. Tour the mill, watch the workings of the waterwheel, and embrace the serenity of the Patoka River.

Jasper Downtown Shopping District

This beautiful area of Jasper is filled with vitality, history, and a variety of shops. Main Street and the area around the square provide an ideal background for great shopping and special festivities throughout the year. More than 20 of Jasper's oldest sites are in the downtown area.

L.H. Sturm Hardware Co.

516 Main St., Jasper; 812.482.6506

Constructed in 1886, this building was purchased by the Sturm family in 1895 for operation as a hardware store. It stands today as one of the oldest hardware stores in Indiana that has continually been operated as a hardware store by the same family. It is on the National Register of Historic Places.

River Centre

225 River Centre Landing, Jasper; 812.559.0111; jasperrivercentre.com

The Jasper River Centre is expected to be the hub of downtown activity in Jasper. For 2021, this new complex, located next to the Patoka River, RiverWalk, Jasper Mill and Spirit of Jasper Train and Depot, features special events throughout the year, including themed rooftop dinner parties. The St. Benedicts Brewery is also housed at the River Centre as a second location brewery.

Schaeffer Barn and Alexander Schoolhouse


E. 4th & McCrillus St., Jasper; 812.482.4255; historicjasper.com

This historic, hand-hewn log barn and single-room, 1918 schoolhouse are located near the new Cultural Center and Jasper Riverwalk. Originally built in the 1800s, the barn features a Cantilever Overhang typical of many German buildings during the time with a unique construction of half-dovetail notches, log cribs with 26-foot feeding troughs, and a stone foundation. The historic Alexander Schoolhouse was moved from its location south of Ireland and restored to be used for school trips, library programs, and as a tourist attraction.

Schnitzelbank Restaurant

393 3rd. Ave., Jasper; 812.482.2640; schnitzelbank.com

Opened in 1961, this restaurant is widely known for its authentic German cuisine and ranks as one of the top ten independent restaurants in Indiana. Enjoy dishes commonly found in southern Germany or for the not-so-German, check out the salad, soup and bread bar or one of the many American favorites.

Huntingburg Historic Fourth Street Shopping

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this historic business district, once destroyed by a fire in 1889, has been restored to a charming Victorian downtown, housing more than two dozen locally-owned antique and specialty shops and eateries. Most of the two-story Italianate and late Victorian buildings were built in the 1800s and early 1900s.

Huntingburg Old Town Hall & Market Street Park

309 N. Geiger St., Huntingburg; 812.683.2994 The Old Town Hall is an 1887 Italianate structure featuring authentic Victorian lighting, elongated windows, 14-inch brick walls, and the original tin ceiling. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this building once served as a fire station and jail, and later as the focal point for the town's events through the 1930s. After several decades, the building was renovated and is in full use today for special events. The Market Street Park has an amphitheater and connects Old Town Hall to Historic 4th Street creating the perfect venue for concerts, festivals, and other popular events.

Amish Country - Montgomery

Experience the quiet lifestyle of the Amish, who first settled in southern Indiana during the mid-1850s. Tour homes, guilt and craft stores, woodworking establishments, and buggy, wheel and harness shops. (21 miles northwest of Jasper)

French Lick and West Baden

Visit these historic towns and tour the magnificent West Baden Dome or enjoy one of Indiana's finest casinos with 1,300 slot machines, 41 table games, and a 14-table poker room. Enjoy a relaxing train ride from the Jasper Train Depot to the Casino aboard the "Spirit of Jasper" train on the "French Lick Express" excursion. (25 miles northeast of Jasper)

Holiday World & Splashin' Safari Santa Claus

Enjoy this family-friendly theme and water park combo with more than 60 holiday-themed rides, slides, shows and attractions. Holiday World features three of the world's top wooden roller coasters and the nation's only launched wing coaster. Splashin' Safari includes the world's two longest water coasters plus water-play activities for smaller children. (23 miles south of Jasper)

Santa Claus, Indiana

Visit the magical Santa's Candy Castle and the Santa Claus Museum & Village and discover the story of Santa Claus! (23 miles south of Jasper)

Lincoln Amphitheatre, Lincoln Boyhood National **Memorial & Living Historical Farm** Lincoln Citv

Learn about the boyhood years of Abraham Lincoln. Tour the visitor's center, the burial place of Lincoln's mother, and the Living Historical Farm where farming currently takes place on the same fields Abe and his father farmed nearly 200 years ago. For entertainment, visit the Lincoln Amphitheatre, an 1,500-seat outdoor amphitheatre. (20 miles south of Jasper)

Holy Family Church

950 E. Church Ave., Jasper (off 3rd Ave.); 812.482.3076

This modern architectural marvel, built with authentic Indiana limestone, features the nation's second largest Dalle-de-Verre (faceted glass) window and the longest unsupported roof beam at 130 feet, six and a half inches.

Ireland Historical Society

5173 W. Walnut St., Jasper; 812.639.7646; irelandindiana.com

Built in 1878 as the Ireland Methodist Church, this is the oldest building in Ireland, a town a few miles west of Jasper. The building was refurbished and now serves as a meeting house. The main floor features the Ireland Historical Chapel, which may be requested for weddings. The basement highlights a 1,000 picture and fact collection covering the interior.

Lemmons Church

7399 W. Portersville Rd., Jasper; 812.639.7646; irelandindiana.com Featured on the National Register of Historic Places, this church was built in 1860 and restored in 1992. The Greek Revival structure maintains its original pews and 14' ceilings. The adjacent cemetery officially became public in 1935 and is currently an ongoing cemetery. A detailed history and pictures are on display inside the church.

Monastery Immaculate Conception

802 E. 10th St., Ferdinand (off Hwy. 162); 812.367.1411; thedome.org Known as the "Castle on the Hill," the Monastery, founded in 1867, is home to one of the nation's largest communities of Benedictine women. The distinctive, Romanesque dome rises majestically over the town of Ferdinand, standing at 87 feet from the floor and 32 and a half feet in diameter. Throughout the church, 89 angels are present, 16 of which are depicted on the stained glass windows surrounding the dome. The church is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and has been designated an Official Project of Save America's Treasures. The Monastery Gift Shop offers handmade crafts from the sisters and other unique spiritual merchandise. Benedictine Hospitality Center, also on the Monastery grounds, offers a peaceful and rejuvenating getaway.

Salem United Church of Christ

202 E. 4th St., Huntingburg; 812.683.2213; salemucc.org Listed on the National Register of historic places, this church was originally established in 1842 by German immigrants. The third and final building that stands today was built in 1889 and highlights Victorian Gothic architecture and a very unique second-floor sanctuary. The church also appeared in the movie "Hard Rain."

Shiloh Meeting House

4060 W. Shiloh Rd., Jasper; 812.639.7646; irelandindiana.com Erected in 1849 and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this building is known as one of the finest pioneer churches in southern Indiana and features its original pews and floors. A 2-door front door and a divider on some of the pews once served to separate the men from the women. Shiloh also has the distinction of having one of the very few pet cemeteries in the state separated from the main cemetery by Shiloh Road.

St. Joseph Church

13th & Newton St., Jasper; 812.482.1805; saintjosephjasper.org Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this magnificent 1880 Romanesque, old world-style church was built by the early parishioners and showcases priceless German stained-glass windows, Austrian-designed and imported mosaics with 50 million stones, pewter and marble statues, altars made of Italian marble, and a communion railing of onyx and brass. The tower, whose design was taken from that of the tower that houses Big Ben in London, stands at 235 feet tall. Today, the church has nearly 5,000 parishioners.

St. Meinrad Archabbey - St. Meinrad

Founded in 1854 by Switzerland monks, the Archabbey is home to over 100 Benedictine monks and offers beautiful architecture as well as a peaceful and spiritual retreat. (21 miles southeast of Jasper)



Jasper Riverwalk

Off 3rd Ave. near Patoka River, Jasper; historicjasper.com Explore the simplicity of nature with a walk or bike ride on this 2.1-mile paved path in the center of Jasper. Running along the Patoka River in the "Old Jasper" district, the Riverwalk features a beautiful gazebo, three footbridges, shelter houses, seating along the river, and indoor restroom facilities.

Patoka Lake Recreation Area

Hwy. 164, Wickliffe; 812.685.2464; patokalakeindiana.com With 8,800 acres of water encompassed by a 26,000-acre recreation area, Patoka Lake is Indiana's second largest reservoir offering Hoosier Hills Marina, ten launch ramps, a beach, nature trails, bike trails, and campsites. Activities include fishing, archery, hunting, boating, water skiing, hiking, bicycling, and swimming. The lake is also a nesting site for bald eagles & osprey.

Awards include repeat recognition in Golfweek Magazine's Top 10 Best Courses You Can Play in Indiana and Best Public Golf Course in Indiana by the INGCOA. The course extends over 260 rolling acres of woods, water and wildlife. The well-manicured course displays the natural beauty of this former southern Indiana horse farm, a peaceful waterfall on hole 18, true and fast Bentgrass greens, plus Zoysia fairways and tee boxes. Additional amenities include cart GPS, a banquet center and executive chef.

Buffalo Trace Golf Course

1728 Jackson St., Jasper; 812.482.4600 Buffalo Trace is an exciting and challenging 18-hole regulation course. From the longest tees it presents 5,985 yards of golf for a par of 71. The course was designed by Gary Kern, ASGCA, and opened in 1970. The course rating is 69.5 with a slope rating of 111. Buffalo Trace is a municipal golf course with an 'Open To Public' guest policy.




